



PARENTS' BILL OF RIGHTS



We the People assert and affirm that Parents are the primary educators of our children. Parents have the sacred responsibility and duty to raise and educate our children in a manner that honors God, values the family, instills faith, character, and virtue, and equips and prepares them to be productive and honorable citizens of the United States of America. To protect and ensure these truths, we assert the following rights of Parents.

PARENTS HAVE THE RIGHT:

AUTHORITY

1. To make all academic decisions for their children.
2. To make all medical decisions for their children and end secret medical treatment, communication, and coercion.

SAFETY

3. To an environment free from indoctrination, ideological coercion, political bias, segregation, & discrimination.
4. To a safe school environment for their children including the right to privacy, free speech, and fair competition in sports.
5. To a safe school environment for teachers including on-campus security and swift response to disruptive behavioral issues.

TRANSPARENCY

6. To scheduled access to their children's learning environment.
7. To complete transparency and online access to all class curriculum, instructional training, activities, lesson plans, library book inventories, and learning materials.
8. To educational materials not provided by or sourced by controversial outside organizations.
9. To a representative, highly responsive, transparent School Board and the ability to speak at board meetings and hold board members accountable for educational metrics and performance.

OPPORTUNITY

10. To choose, as an alternative to public education, private, religious, or home schools and move their children to schools that recognize our rights.
